#### Qualifying Requirements / Eligibility Criteria:

1. The Bidder (sole or consortium) should have carried out design / engineering, supply, erection / supervision of erection, commissioning / supervision of commissioning of Automatic Valve Less Gravity (AVG / VAG) Filters having a minimum total filtration capacity of 1000 m³/hr for at least one (01) no. of project in the past, as on the date of NIT, located in India.

Copies of the following documents shall be submitted by the Bidder in support of the above:

- Letter of Intent or Award Letter or Work Order or Contract Document or Purchase Order issued by the Client.
- b) Commissioning Certificate or Performance Certificate or Completion Certificate or Final Acceptance Certificate issued by the Client.
- 2. In case the Bidder is a Consortium (of maximum 4 members including the Consortium leader) wherein one or more of the Consortium members, either individually or together, fulfill the criteria as per Para 1, the experience of remaining member(s) should be commensurate with the roles & responsibilities defined in the responsibility matrix provided in the Consortium Agreement, w.r.t the key areas, as mentioned in Para 1 above.

Copies of the following documents showing experience as per the responsibility matrix for each member of the Consortium, as applicable, should be submitted by the Bidder in support of the above:

- a) Memorandum of Agreement and Responsibility Matrix.
- b) LOI or Award Letter or Work Order or Contract Document or Purchase Order issued by the Client.
- c) Commissioning Certificate or Performance Certificate or Completion Certificate or Final Acceptance Certificate issued by the Client.
- **3.** The **Average Annual Financial Turnover** of the Bidder(s) during the last three consecutive financial years ending 31.03.2017 shall be at least **Rs. 6.5 Crore** (Rupees Six Crore and Fifty Lakh only).
  - In case of Bidder being Consortium, the Average Annual Financial Turnover of each individual member of the Consortium during last three (03) consecutive financial years shall not be less than **Rs. 0.65 crore** (Rupees Sixty Five Lakh only). However, the total Average Annual Turnover of the Consortium (taken

together for all the Consortium members) during the last three (03) consecutive financial years shall not be less than **Rs. 6.5 crore** (Rupees Six Crore and Fifty Lakh only).

The Bidder shall submit audited Annual Financial Reports for last three (03) consecutive financial years ending 31.03.2017 in support of the above.

Further, the Bidder (all Bidders in case of Consortium) shall also submit a certificate from the concerned Merchant Bankers that the loans given to the Bidder are not falling in the category of Non-Performing Assets of the concerned Banks.

#### 4. Other Conditions:

- 4.1. Notwithstanding anything stated above, BPSCL reserves the right to assess the Bidder's capability and capacity to perform, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BPSCL.
- 4.2. The Bidder shall submit authenticated documentary evidence of all above along with the tender.
- 4.3. The original documents are to be produced on demand.

#### **General Terms and Conditions**

#### 1. SUBMISSION OF BANK GUARANTEE FOR QUOTING UNWORKABLE RATE:

If a tenderer quotes unworkable rates i.e. if the quoted price is less than the lower limit of the estimated price and is considered for placement of order, the party will be asked to justify the rate quoted and will have to give Performance Guarantee Bond (in addition to the Security Deposit) in the form of Bank Draft/Bank Guarantee. The amount of Performance Guarantee Bond will be decided by BPSCL at the time of placement of order. Earnest Money of the tenderers who refuse to give Performance Guarantee Bond will be forfeited and they will not be considered for taking participation in any kind of Tender for next Six (06) months from the date of issue of letter to the Defaulter Firm, if order / contract is not finalised from the present tender.

#### 2. EXEMPTION OF COST OF BIDDING DOCUMENT & BID SECURITY:

However, Micro & small enterprises (MSEs) / PSU /Govt. Undertakings and Co-operative societies will be exempted from submission of cost of tender document & Earnest Money as per government policy.
