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Bokaro Power Supply Company (P) Ltd. (BPSCL), A Joint Venture Company of Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL) and Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC), situated in Bokaro Steel City, Jharkhand, invites online digitally signed ebids in Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) (using Class-II or above Digital Signature Certificate) for the referred work in Power Plant of BPSCL.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested bidder from BPSCL's website (www.bpscl.com) or the e-tendering site (https://etenders.gov.in).

Bidder shall not tamper / modify the tender document / form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case the same is found to be tampered / modified in any manner, bid will be rejected and EMD will be forfeited and Bidder shall be liable to be banned from doing business with BPSCL for a suitable period as per policy of BPSCL.

Intending Bidders are advised to visit CPPP website https://etenders.gov.in regularly till closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / addendum / amendment.

Financial Capability:

 Bidder should have Minimum average annual turnover (MAT) of Rs. 145.57 Lakhs in preceding three (03) Consecutive Financial years.

Note:

- a) Average annual turnover shall be determined taking into consideration turnover of preceding three consecutive financial years. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- b) Audited annual accounts along with auditor's report of the bidder should be furnished in support of the same. Where audited annual account is not mandatory as per the law, the bidder has to submit annual financial turnover during the consecutive last three (03) years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year duly certified by CA.

Technical Capability:

- 2. Bidder should have experience of having completed similar work in India in any Public Sector Undertaking / Government / Semi Government organization or joint venture thereof / Company registered under Companies Act during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which offers are invited. Value of such work order shall be either of the following:
 - a) Three similar completed works each costing not less than to Rs. 194.09 Lakhs
 OR
 - b) Two similar completed works each costing not less than to **Rs. 242.62 Lakhs**OR
 - c) One similar completed work costing not less than to Rs. 388.19 Lakhs

Similar Work means Erection & Commissioning of Coal Handling Plant for plant size 100 MW or above for coal handling system of capacity 300 TPH or more in power plants and the above coal handling plant should have been in operation for a period of at least one (01) year from the date of successful commissioning of entire system.

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The bidder should have executed any of the following work for plant size 100 MW or above for Coal handling system having capacity 300 TPH or more in any power plant,

i) Operation & Maintenance of Coal Handling Plant

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ii) Mechanical Maintenance of Coal Handling Plant

or

iii) Overhauling of Coal Handling Plant

Note:

- i. Completed Work means the executed / completed portion of Work Order / Annual Maintenance Contract / Rate Contract, even if the work has not been completed in totality (subject to furnishing proof of executed value of work in the form of certified copies of RA Bills) along with successful work execution certificate (by the concerned authority).
- ii. Partially completed work orders having validity of more than one year shall be considered for Technical Evaluation conforming to the definition of Similar Nature Work in the work order for assessment of eligibility as per Eligibility Criteria if the Bidder has completed at least 01 (one) year of the period of the work order.
- iii. Work Order, whose total work duration is one year or less than one year, will only be considered for Technical Evaluation if work execution against the same has been completed in totality.
- iv. Completed Sub-orders issued against Rate Contract shall be considered after completion of 01 (one) year period of that Rate Contract. All Sub-Orders completed by a bidder under one Rate Contract will be considered as single work order for evaluation as per Eligibility Criteria.
- 2.1 In support of their eligibility and experience, the bidder is required to submit copies of work orders & completion certificates (by the concerned competent authority) along with the techno-commercial bid.
- 3. Consortium Bidding: Bidders as a consortium will be considered :

A. Consortium Requirement:

- i. Bidder may quote as a consortium of not more than two (02) members. The consortium members should individually or collectively fulfill the requirements of clause 1 & 2 above and shall furnish along with the bid, an agreement in prescribed format jointly executed by them for successful completion of job contract for Assistance in Operation and Maintenance (Mechanical) of CHP & FOS shall be submitted along with Bid.
- ii. All other terms and conditions for participation in the tender as a consortium shall be as below at SI. No 3 B.
- iii. Each member of the consortium shall furnish Audited Statements of Accounts, Auditors Report and the Directors' Report for the last three consecutive financial years along with the bid. (Where audited annual account is not mandatory as per the law, annual financial turnover during the last

- three (03) consecutive years, ending 31st march of the previous financial year duly certified by CA shall be submitted)
- iv. The AAT of any of the member of the Consortium should not be less than **Rs.14.55 Lakh** during the preceding three consecutive financial years as on the date of Bid submission. The bidder(s) must submit the Audited Financial Statements in support of this. (Where audited annual account is not mandatory as per the law, annual financial turnover during the last three (03) consecutive years, ending 31st march of the previous financial year duly certified by CA shall be submitted)
 - B. Bids submitted by a consortium (not more than two (02) parties) shall comply with the following requirements:
 - The bid shall include all the information on eligibility/ qualification and experience required for a Bidder as described in Bidding Documents.
 - (ii) The bid shall be signed so as to be legally binding on all members.
 - (iii) The members of the Consortium shall nominate one member as the "Lead Member", responsible for overall performance of the Contract. The nomination shall be supported by a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and should be signed by all the legally authorized signatories of all members. The leader shall be the member having maximum job or share of work in value terms.
 - (iv) The leader shall be authorised to incur liabilities and receive instructions and payment for and on behalf of any & all members of the consortium. However, payments shall be released directly to consortium members provided the Leader of the consortium submits a general authorisation document, authorising the Employer to release payment to its consortium members directly.
 - (v) Leader of the consortium shall be overall responsible for the execution of the Contract. The Leader and other Members of the Consortium shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the Contract, but will be liable for damages in proportion of the respective Contract Price.
 - (vi) A copy of the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) entered into by the consortium members prior to stipulated due date of submission of bids and valid till Time for Completion plus Defect Liability Period for the Facilities shall be submitted. The MoA shall clearly outline the proposed roles & responsibilities of each member. Each member of consortium must have the experience for the component of the contract that they are designated to perform. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in rejection of the Consortium's bid.
 - (vii) Separate bid by a consortium member will not be accepted. A party can be a member in only one consortium; bids submitted by such consortia which include the same party as member and/or leader will be rejected. Bidders are not allowed to form new consortium (consortia) with other Bidders participating in the tender. The composition or the constitution of the consortium, who have become eligible, may be permitted to alter only with the prior consent of the Employer in writing.
 - (viii) For the purpose of formation of consortium, a member shall be an independent and single legal entity as per laws of India or as per laws in the country of such member and should have its own independent financial accounting system as per laws of India or as per laws in the country of such member.
- 9. Tender Validity
 Period

 a. Validity of the offer shall be at least Six (06) months from the Bid Opening Date. In case of extension of "Bid Submission / Opening Date", the validity will be counted from the extended Bid Submission End Date.

 b. In case prices are finalized through Reverse Auction / Price Negotiation, the validity of the final quoted price shall be two (02) months from the date of discovery of the final L-1 price, either through Reverse Auction or through Price Negotiation, as the case may be, or till the validity of the techno-commercial bid, whichever is later.

 10. Reverse Auction

 Rates will be finalized through Reverse Auction among techno-commercially accepted bidders which will be conducted through the CPP Portal. The procedure for the same is detailed in Section III of this tender document.

- a) If a Bidder withdraws its bid after opening of bids without giving any satisfactory and acceptable explanation thereof, the Bidder shall be debarred from participating in any tender of BPSCL for a minimum period of 01 (one) year.
- b) Bidder has the option of visiting the work site for actual assessment of the job before submission of offer.
- c) Any conditional offer or offer having deviations is liable to be rejected.
- d) Bidder is advised to mention page number on each page of documents submitted by him / her. BPSCL shall not bear any responsibility in case of any loss of documents submitted by the bidder during tender opening or thereafter.
- e) If the Bidder is a Firm or Company, then it shall, in the forwarding letter, mention the number and names of all the partners & shall sign before submitting the same, unless the Power of Attorney holder has specifically been authorized in this respect.
- f) Price or any indication of price shall **NOT** be mentioned in the Techno-Commercial Bid.
- g) The tenders received will be opened on scheduled opening date and time in the office of Material Management, in presence of such bidders who might choose to witness the same
- In case the date of tender opening happens to be a holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
- i) Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): BPSCL reserves the right to exercise Purchase Preference i.r.o Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as per guidelines mentioned in the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012, amendments thereto issued by the Government of India through Office Memorandums dated 17.04.2018 & 14.11.2018 and any other amendments issued by the Government till the date of opening of offers received against this tender.
- j) Offers from two or more bidders shall summarily be rejected if they have any of the following parameters in common:
 - i) Same PAN
 - ii) Same GST Number
 - iii) Same Postal address
 - iv) Same E-mail ID
 - v) Same Mobile number
 - vi) Same person signing in more than one offer / representing more than one bidder.
- k) BPSCL reserves the right to:
 - i) Retender / extend the due date of submission of offer.
 - ii) Accept or reject any offer / all offers in full or part at any time at any stage without assigning any reasons and without any compensation thereof to the bidders.
 - iii) Modify the tender documents at any stage before the due date of tender.
